WHEN: **Wednesday, May 22, 2024**

8:00 a.m.– 5:45 p.m. [bus departs from HCC bus parking lot by Gaskins Rd.]

WHO: Historic Christ Church Volunteers, Interested Spouses, and Friends & Potential Volunteers (A great way to introduce them to HCC)

WHERE: **Newport Parish Church (St. Luke’s), Isle of Wight County**

Constructed ca. 1680–85. Oldest Anglican parish church to survive from colonial Virginia. Buttressed walls, shaped gable roof, high water table, and large east-end window typical for late 17th-century Virginia churches. Reconstructed interior.

Isle of Wight Court House, Smithfield

Completed ca. 1751 by undertaker William Rand. T-shaped brick courthouse with front arcade & rear apse. Restored by APVA in 1960. Recent interior restorations.

Lunch at Smithfield Station (*see choices below; included in trip price*)

Bacon’s Castle, Surry County

Built by Arthur Allen ca. 1665. English bond brickwork over high water table. Originally a cross-plan building with towers front and back. Diagonally set, triple chimney stacks and shaped gable roof. Exposed interior framing members.

Ferry – Return across the James River and enjoy views of Historic Jamestowne

1. **Cesar Salad w/Blackened Salmon or Chicken** on crisp romaine lettuce tossed w/parmesan cheese and Caesar dressing. Topped with lemon, croutons & red onion.
2. **Fried Flounder Sandwich:** Large filet of fresh farm-raised flounder lightly breaded and fried, served on a toasted home-baked roll w/lettuce, tomato and onion. Served with French fries OR coleslaw.
3. **Reuben:** Corn beef sliced thin and piled high on Marble Rye w/sauerkraut and 1000 Island and grilled. Served with French fries OR coleslaw.
4. **Chicken Salad Plate** Chunks of chicken w/celery, grapes, and a Hellmann’s® based dressing served on a bed of salad greens w/tomato, cucumber, fresh fruit, coleslaw, and crackers.
